We are on list 3 now, review all weekly. Thank you!

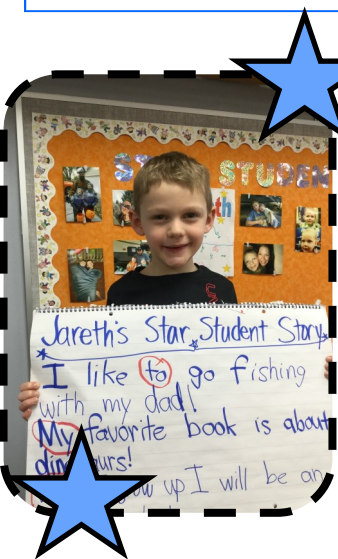
Dear Parents,
