Dear Parents,

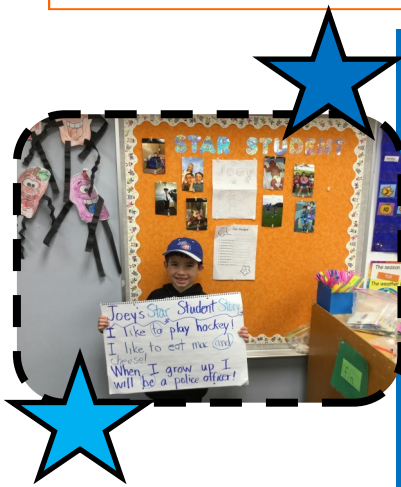
