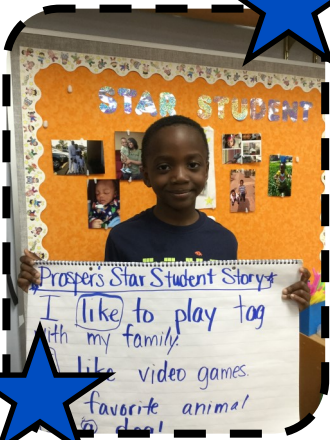
Dear Parents,

This week we worked on counting to 100 by 10's and 1's and practiced counting items carefully with some different activities. We love our Wednesday problem solving activities as well and are beginning to really think about math ideas!

In science we worked on pushes and pulls and which direction things move including vocabulary such as towards and away. The students drew things they can push or pull in their science notebook and sang a song to help them remember what a push and pull does.

During reading small groups we worked hard on phonemic awareness including finding the syllables in words, segmenting and blending sounds, changing sounds in words, and those tricky rhyming words!
