We also worked on combining shapes to make new ones and told the teacher what was the same and different about those shapes! Whew! Next week we move onto numbers!

In science, we read about our Monarchs and how they are migrating insects during the fall. We will finish with a life cycle project next week while we wait for our last 6 chrysalis to emerge. If all of them make it each child in our class will have named a butterfly! Amazing!

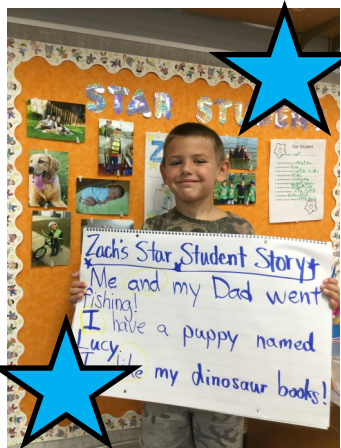
Homework bags are due back to school on Monday. Please read those books again over the weekend. Sight word list stays at home to begin a sight word routine.

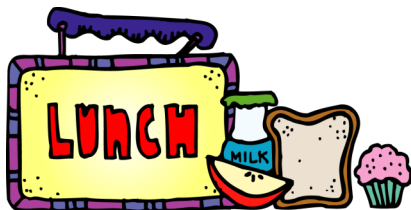
